Ladies,

Due to the high demand of ladies who expressed the desire to participate in the upcoming "2 Person Scramble" Event scheduled for May 18th, the League has opted to change the format of this event to allow all 80 ladies to play.

The changes are:

- NOT A SHOTGUN START.
- The League is NOT ordering additional carts.
- No need to arrive at 7:30 for most of you.
- Using regular tee times beginning at 7:30.
- You can walk or ride, whichever you prefer.
- Lunch will start at 11:00 AM and be available to ALL who have opted to remain after play to eat with fellow members of the league.
- We will ensure that EVERYONE WHO IS HAVING LUNCH WILL HAVE THE SAME OPTIONS AND OTHERS WILL BE AT THE EVENT CENTER TO LUNCH WITH YOU!
- Based on signup's and previous play times all have been assigned a partner (if you didn't select one) and a tee time.
- Attached is list of playing partners and tee times.
- PLEASE ARRIVE, AT LEAST 30 MINUTES PRIOR TO YOUR SCHEDULED START TIME, AS JIM WILL PROBABLY GET EVERYONE OUT AHEAD OF THE SCHEDULED TEE TIME. (Means you will get back faster, too!)
- We will announce the winners in "Messages" the following week and prizes will be available on June 1, the next scheduled "League Play" day. (No Golf on May 25 for Memorial Day)

80 ladies playing will be largest turn out for one of our Events and I, along with the other Officers are so excited.

Please let ME KNOW, ASAP, if you cannot play on May 18th. Also, remember that lunch RSVP is due by next Friday, May 8th. Money for lunch due May 11th.

I hope everyone will still be able to participate, as planned.

Lunch will be served after 11:00 as ladies return from playing golf. We will be setting up lunches in small batches to have freshly set out lunches as you arrive. Speaking of lunches, I was able to collect all the money for the lunches aside from just 3 of you. Since you didn't play on Monday, I will collect from you this coming Monday. - A ball is NOT considered "across" the creek until it has successfully landed on the other side AND is playable. You MUST drop "no closer to the Pin" which means you still need to cross it successfully. Other leagues may play it differently, but not us.
- Please DO NOT SEARCH FOR GOLF BALLS ON PRIVATE PROPERTY! Consider your ball "lost", take your penalty and drop, in play, as near as you can to where the ball went "OUT OF BOUNDS", again, "no closer to the Pin".
