- 1. Shotgun start at 8:00 AM
- 2. Be at course by 7:30 AM to pay, get team picture taken and be ready to go to stating holes by 8
- 3. Everyone MUST ride in a cart
- 4. A "Pink" Team player will play against a "Blue" Team play who has a similar handicap/skill level
- 5. Only keep score for your twosome
- 6. Playing for Points based on score for each hole
 - 1. 2 Points for winning (having lower score on the hole)
 - 2. 1 Point each for ties
- 7. Mulligan or Free Out of Water are IN PLAY
- 8. "Birdie"/"Chip-In" are IN PLAY
- 9. Scores WILL count for Handicaps
- 10. End of round add up individual scores and points
- 11. Points will be verified and added for all "Pink" and "Blue" team players
 - 1. The 'TEAM' WITH THE MOST POINTS WIN!
- 12. Lunch after where winning team will be announced and awards given

 - 1. If you have something in your team color, please wear it (we will take a "Team Photo" b/4 play)
- 4. Sorry, not telling you who you are playing against. Don't want any "scoping out the competition" before hand. You will be paired to play against someone of similar skill level.
- 5. Pink Player and Blue Player ride in the same cart, keep their own score and points.
- 6. Points are: 2 to whoever has the best score on each hole. 1 to both if there is a tie.
- 7. MAX score is still "Double Pat".
 - 1. Please CIRCLE on score card if reached,
 - 2. If the other player doesn't MAX score, they win 2 Points.
- 8. Mulligan and/or Free Out of Water ARE in play
- 9. "Birdie" and "Chip-In" COUNT
- 10.Scores COUNT for Handicaps
- 11. After play, add up individual scores, Pink Points and Blue Points b/4 turning in the score card
- 12.Lunch after for those who signed up.
