## **MLGA MESSAGES – JUNE 2023**


### **June 1, 2023**

This is the week for July SignUpGenius to open. Watch for it on June 15<sup>th</sup>! Just a note, we are having regular League Play on July 3<sup>rd</sup> if you are not celebrating at the lake or elsewhere for the 4<sup>th</sup> of July.

Next Monday we are playing "PINK BALL"! This is really fun and the way we play it your scores count for handicaps. Everyone keeps their own individual score just like any other week, NO PINK BALL SCORE to worry about. Your "Team" is whoever you are signed up to play with.

- 1. Every "Team" gets a MLGA PINK BALL to use.
- 2. Select an order to rotate playing the PINK BALL for the ENTIRE HOLE.
- 3. Continue that rotation for all 9 holes.
- 4. Free Out of Water and/or Mulligan are in play for each player.
- 5. PINK BALL goes into the creek, it's NOT lost if you can retrieve it. You can either take the "freebee" or the penalty and keep on playing with it . (REMEMBER; **Only 3 minutes** to search for or attempt to retrieve a ball.)
- 6. If your team does lose the PINK BALL, you are out of the competition to win money at the end BUT you are NOT done playing. Continue using your own ball and continue to keep your score.
- 7. Please don't become upset if "Pinkie" gets lost, it happens A LOT when we play this game.
